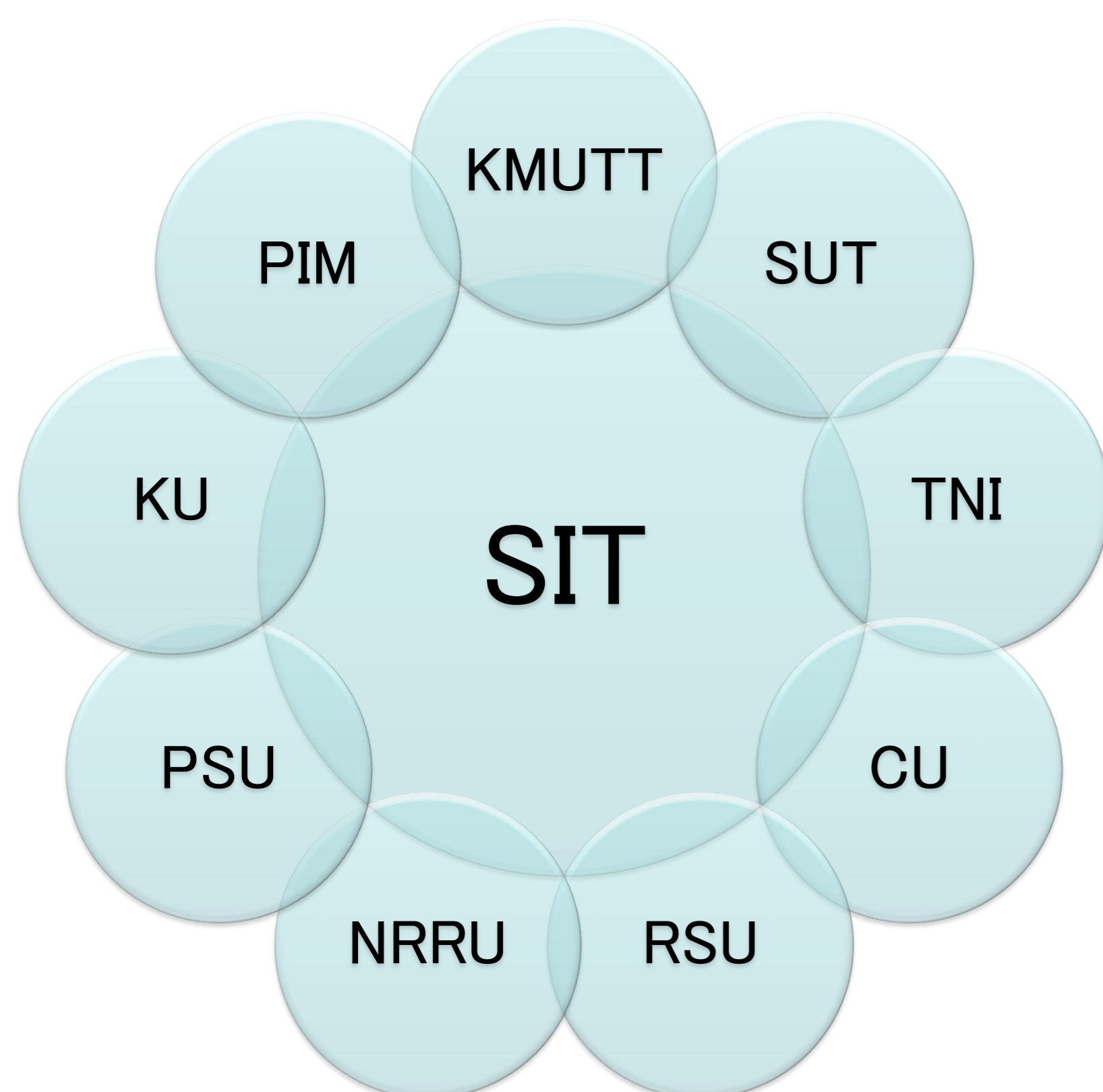

Hybrid Twining Program

- Master and Doctoral course program.
- Thai students study at both home university and SIT.

Internship

- 2-4 week program
- Students have practical experiences for beginners in an occupation or profession. (reciprocal)

Global PBL

- 2-4 week program
- Students put forward their proposals and present their ideas on technical issues.(reciprocal)

Joint Research

- Faculty members jointly tackle their research theme.

Student Exchange

- 1-2 semester program
- Students take courses and/or do research. (reciprocal)

English Learning Program

- 2 week program
- Japanese students study practical English in Thailand.
