## Kansai University Japanese Language and Culture Programs

### Preparatory Course (Bekka)



The purpose of this course is to provide instruction in the Japanese language, Japan studies and Japanese culture to international students who intend to enter Kansai University or another Japanese university as a degree-seeking student after passing the entrance examination.

#### ■ Application period

Apr. Admission: Sep. 8, 2017 - Oct. 2, 2017  
Sep. Admission: Apr. 6, 2018 - May 1, 2018

#### ■ Period of study

1 year in principal but it can be extended up to 2 years

### Japanese Language and Culture Course (JLC)



The purpose of JLC is to provide instruction in the Japanese language and Japanese Culture to international students who are enrolled in or have graduated from universities and graduate schools outside of Japan. The course consists of 'Japanese Language Class' and 'Japan Studies Class'. The former is taught in Japanese and the latter in English.

#### ■ Application Period

Apr. Admission: Sep. 6, 2017 - Oct. 25, 2017  
Sep. Admission: Mar. 7, 2018 - Apr. 25, 2018

#### ■ Period of study and Admission

1 semester (half a year) or 2 semesters (1 year)

The JLC employs the semester system so that students can start the course either in the Spring (April - September) or the Fall Semester (September - March next year)

#### ■ Tuition (JPY)

500,000 per semester

### Intensive Japanese Language and Culture Course (IJLC)



The purpose is to provide instruction to international undergraduate and graduate students in a short period of time not only in the Japanese language, but also in Japan studies. The course includes field trips to Kyoto etc., and Japanese cultural experiences which enable participants to learn and understand the Japanese language, culture and society from various perspectives.

#### ■ Period of study

2 to 3 weeks in summer and winter

#### ■ Course fee per person

The range of the course fee is approx. ¥190,000 to ¥290,000 depends on accommodation type.

The course fees includes Japanese class, Japanese culture experiences, field trip, instructions with KU students, course materials, accommodation fee (the student's choice of accommodation) and transportation fees between an airport in Osaka.
