Kansai University Japanese Language and Culture Programs

Preparatory Course (Bekka)



The purpose of this course is to provide instruction in the Japanese language, Japan studies and Japanese culture to international students who intend to enter Kansai University or another Japanese university as a degree-seeking student after passing the entrance examination.

■ Application period

Apr. Admission: Sep. 9, 2016 - Oct. 3, 2016
 Sep. Admission: Apr. 7, 2017 - May 1, 2017

■ Period of study

1 year in principal but it can be extended up to 2 years

Japanese Language and Culture Course (JLC)



The purpose is to provide instruction to those students enrolled at foreign universities or graduate schools, or expected to graduate from one of these in Japanese language and culture. The Japanese language classes are held in Japanese, and the Japanese Studies and other classes are conducted in English. Students can participate in varieties of activities with KU students.

■ Application Period

Apr. Admission: Sep. 7, 2016 - Oct. 26, 2016
 Sep. Admission: Mar. 8, 2017 - Apr. 26, 2017

■ Period of study and Admission

1 semester (half a year) or 2 semester (1 year)
 The JLC employs the semester system so that students can start either in the Spring or the Fall semester.

■ Tuition (JPY)

500,000 per semester

Intensive Japanese Language and Culture Course (IJLC)



The purpose is to provide instruction to international undergraduate and graduate students in a short period of time not only in the Japanese language, but also in Japan studies. The course includes field trips to Kyoto or Osaka, and Japanese cultural experiences which enable participants to learn and understand the Japanese language, culture and society from various perspectives.

■ Period of study

2 to 3 weeks in summer and winter

■ Course fee per person

The range of the course fee is approx. ¥189,000 to ¥295,000 depends on accommodation type. The course fees includes Japanese class, Japanese culture experiences, field trip, instructions with KU students, course materials, accommodation fee (the student's choice of accommodation) and transportation fees between an airport in Osaka.
