


Alumni in Thailand

Thai Students' Association in Japan under the Royal Patronage has a long history of 76 years holding about 1,000 Thai students all over Japan. A graduate student of Mie University, was taking a role of representative for the 72nd to the 74th as the Mie Prefecture's head. Currently, another Mie University's student is taking over the role for the 75th head. There are several events all through the year. In April: Awarding Ceremony for the appointment of heads; in May: Thai Festival in Tokyo, Osaka and Nagoya; in November: Thai-Japan Conference. They actively enhance our friendship between Thai and Japan through cultural events and being a bridge for our strong bond. In addition, Old Japan Students' Association, Kingdom of Thailand was established in January, 1966, supporting alumni networks and students who wish to study in Japan.



Renewal of Agreement with Khon Kaen University



On February 3, Professor Komada, President of MIE University and his delegation visited Khon Kaen University. MIE University medical department signed an agreement with Khon Kaen in 1994. In 2000, MIE University signed an agreement at the university level. Both universities visit each other every 5 years to renew the agreement, Khon Kaen University Hospital provides a backup program in clinical training for graduates of the Mie University medical system. Two students were taking this training at the time of President Komada's visit. Dr. Komada believes that this agreement has strengthened mutual cooperation between the two universities and will lead to more active coordination in education and research.
