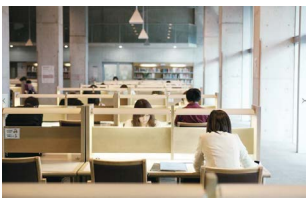
Introduction



Tokyo Metropolitan University is a renowned public university, which is supported by Tokyo Metropolitan Government.

Major activities

■ Tokyo Human Resources Fund for City Diplomacy ■

The Tokyo Metropolitan Government has established the “Asian Human Resources Fund” in 2008, aiming at fostering excellent human resources who will contribute to the development of Asia in the future. They re-established this fund to “Tokyo Human Resources Fund for City Diplomacy” in 2015 for the next ten years.

Under these programs, TMU has provided financial supports to **164students**, including **20 students from Thailand**, who have devoted themselves to studying and research at the Graduate schools.
