Myogadani Campus: Strengthening legal training begins

The Myogadani Campus is an eight-story building with two basement levels, inspired by the red brick building of the Igrisu Horitsu Gakko (English Law School), that preceded Chuo University. State-of-the-art classrooms accommodate distance learning and hybrid classes, while the library and cafeteria feature motifs from the Middle Temple Inn of Court in London, where the English Law School founders studied. The Campus

consists of various areas for student life, student study, and specialized legal study. It is also equipped with a "laboratory floor" for students who aim to pass the difficult examinations of the legal profession and the civil service.

The Koishikawa Campus is the new sports facility in central Tokyo opened in April 2023. In addition to being used for physical education classes, the

Surugadai Campus: Developing professional individuals

The Surugadai Centennial Hall, completed in 1988 as part of the Centennial Commemorative Project, was reborn as the Surugadai Campus in April 2023. With two Professional Graduate Schools, the Chuo Law School (CLS) and the Chuo Graduate School of Strategic Management, Business School (CBS), Chuo can now meet the needs of the legal and business communities, fostering "legal professionals who understand management" and "business professionals who understand the law." The Campus has 20 floors above ground and one below, and features a soaring vertical design that captures Chuo University's trajectory toward the future. In addition to distinctive facilities, such as a moot courtroom, there is a cafeteria on the 19th floor with a panoramic view of urban Tokyo and the western mountains in the distance.

Joint Course launched combining three Faculties

The Law Faculty's relocation enables cooperation with the Faculty of Science and Engineering (Korakuen Campus) and the Faculty of Global Informatics (Ichigaya Tamachi Campus), all located in proximity. The three Faculties have established a new joint course for 1st-year students called "Academic Frontiers," which integrate humanities and sciences. The course provides students with comprehensive perspectives, allowing students from the participating Faculties to study together with outstanding instructors from the three Faculties, synthesizing the essential academic fields of those Faculties. The goal is for 1st-year students to acquire a foundation of multifaceted and flexible creativity as they begin their university studies, collaborating with students from other Faculties and departments and learning various ways to solve the unique problems we face in daily life. In short, "Academic Frontiers" students will learn to master their own studies as well as the approaches used by those outside their fields.
