JSPS POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP FOR RESEARCH IN JAPAN 2025/2026

The scholarship offers opportunities for **post-doctoral researchers** from ASEAN countries to conduct cooperative research under Japanese guidance, aiming to advance their research activities and promote internationalization in Japan. The fellowship welcomes applicants from **all fields of research**.

# **ELIGIBILITY**

# **Eligibility Criteria for Applicant**

- Applicant must meet one in each of the categories below.
  - o Category A: Conditions related to degree
    - Less than 6 years since obtaining a Ph.D. in a country other than Japan
    - Expected to obtain a Ph.D. in a country other than Japan within 2 years from the employment start date
  - Category B: Conditions related to nationality
    - Nationals of ASEAN member countries
    - A person who is a citizen of a country other than an ASEAN member country and has been engaged in research activities for the past three years at a research institution in an ASEAN member country.
- Must receive Letter of Acceptance/Invitation from the candidate's prospective host researcher in Japan (details indicated in Eligibility criteria for host researchers\*).

### <u>Host Researchers\*</u>

- Must be affiliated with a research institution eligible to apply for KAKENHI grants (Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research, JSPS).
- Must be full-time researchers, but exceptions may be made if the host institution can ensure uninterrupted program execution.
- Eligible host institutions include universities, Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports,
   Science and Technology (MEXT) affiliated institutions, colleges of technology, and institutions designated by the Minister of MEXT.
- Host researchers cannot change during the fellowship tenure.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**



Applicants establish contact with prospective host researchers in Japan.



Applicants submit applications via the AUN web portal.



JSPS will announce the result.

1 April 2025 - 31 March 2026 Duration of Fellowship: 1 - 12 months

For Ph.D. holders: 362,000 JPY per month

For Non- Ph.D. holders: 200,000 JPY per month\*

\*If you obtain a degree during the employment period, the fee can be changed to 362,000 yen/month.

### **MISCELLANEOUS EXPENSES**

Settling-in allowance: 200,000 JPY

\*Applicable for Fellows with 3 or more months of tenure
