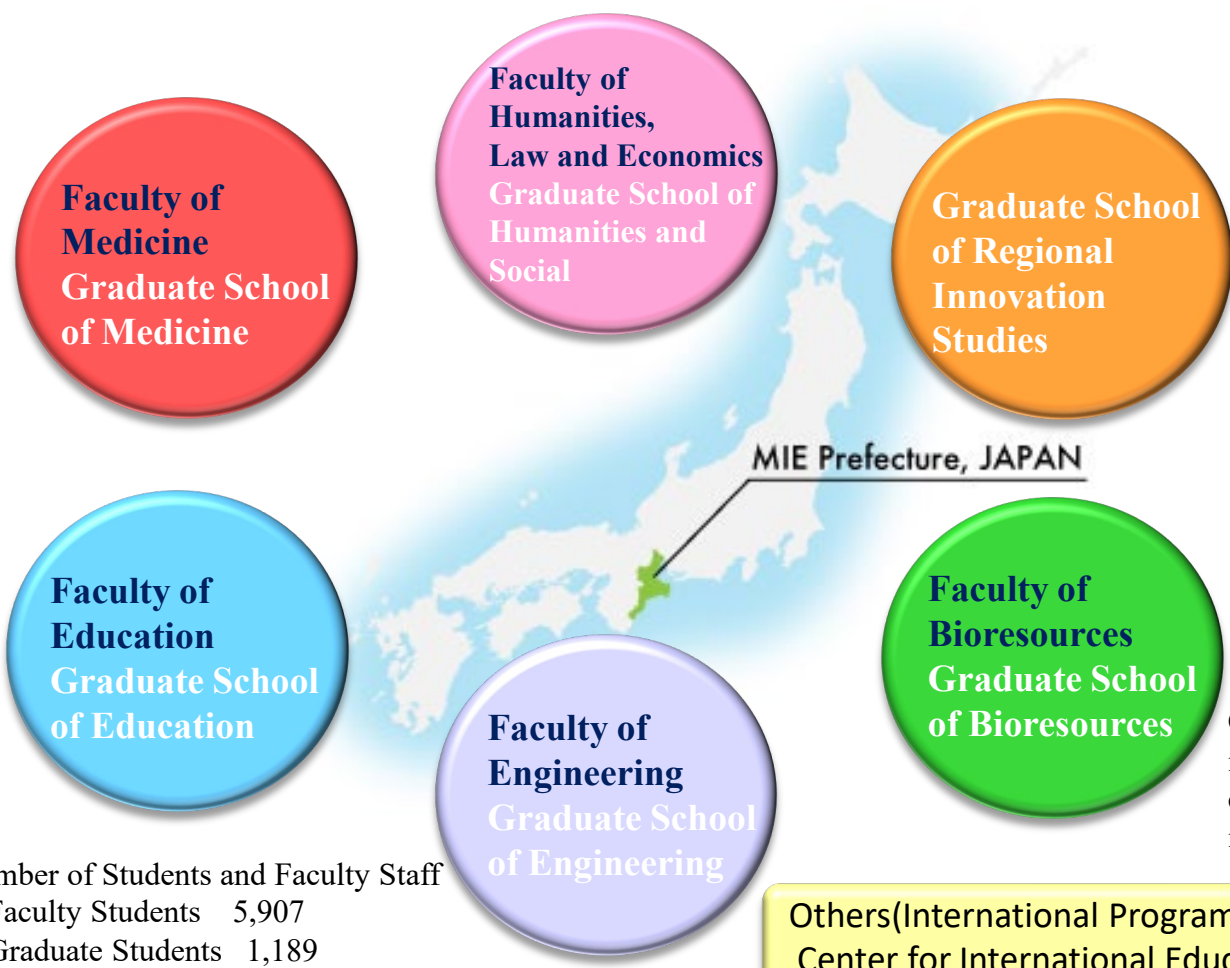




Our Principles

International Activity

Tri-U International Joint Seminar & Symposium

The Tri-U International Joint Seminar & Symposium is international research symposium conducted in English and organized by Mie University (Japan). Chiang Mai University(Thailand). and Jiangsu University (China) The three universities have hosted the event on a rotating basis every year since 1994. IPB University (Indonesia) has also participated as a host since the 2011 academic year, Guangxi University (China) was added since 2018 academic year, and Maejo University (Thailand) was added as a sixth host institution from the 2022 academic year. The event is attended by around 120 students and faculty/staff members from about a dozen universities across Asia every year. It was held at IPB University

in the 2022 academic year, with research presentations and workshops on the themes of “Population,”“ Food,”“Energy,”“Environment” and “Techonpreneurship” aimed exciting opportunity for delegates to explore the future opportunities and challenges for collaboration. In the 2023 academic year, the 29th event will be held on site for the first time in three years, with Maejo University (Thailand) as the host institution.
