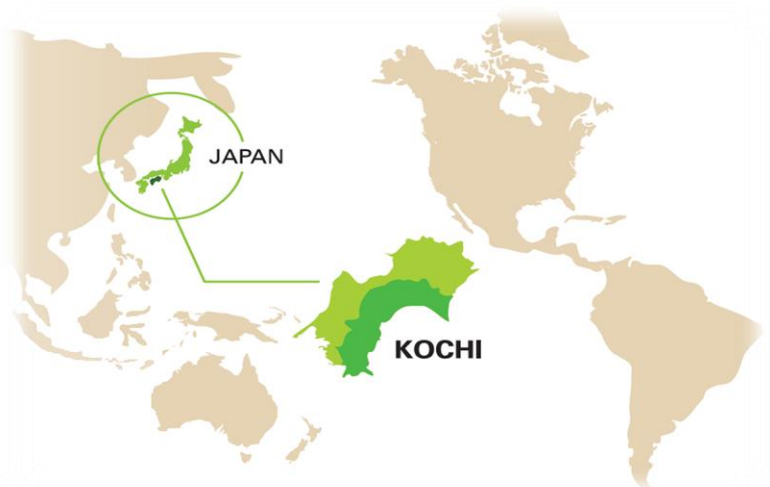
Major activities
